




Dublin v Mayo Allianz NFL Division 1 2020


Dublin 0-14 Mayo 0-8



Despite getting similar shot counts away Dublin's superiority tells in the quality of these shots. Dublin also benefit from positive shooting efficiency versus Mayo's negative efficiency. Dublin's control and patience is evident in the game control and having double the passes per possession leading to a shot as Mayo. This points to their commitment to creating the best possible opportunities and high value shots.

Scores were tight at half time with Mayo possibly shading the first half but the familiar 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter onslaught from the Dubs saw them pull away on the scoreboard.





Shot quality is clear from the shot locations. Dublin regularly got shots off inside the scoring zone whereas Mayo were forced to shoot low % shots from outside the zone. Dublin continue to retain a high % (82% vs Mayo) of kickouts in the absence of Stephen Cluxton but it is interesting to note that they are having difficulties when forced to go mid/long. Mayo's kickout retention of 63% is below where they need to be especially when they are getting picked off inside their own 45. Dublin managed 2 points from the Mayo kickout with the remainder of their scores coming from their own kickouts/transitioning from winning the ball back in their own 3<sup>rd</sup>. Interestingly no Mayo possession originated inside Dublin's 45 – incredible efficiency from the Dubs and points to their patience and ruthlessness.
