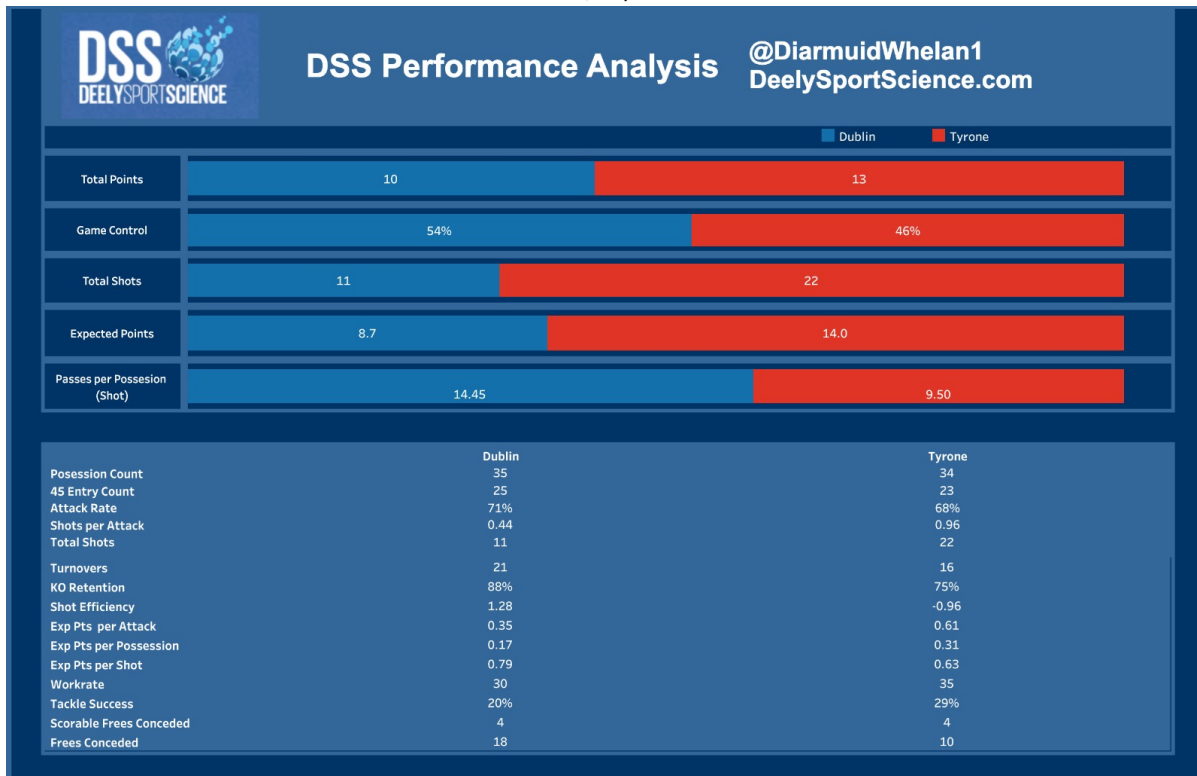




Dublin v Tyrone Allianz NFL Division 1 2020

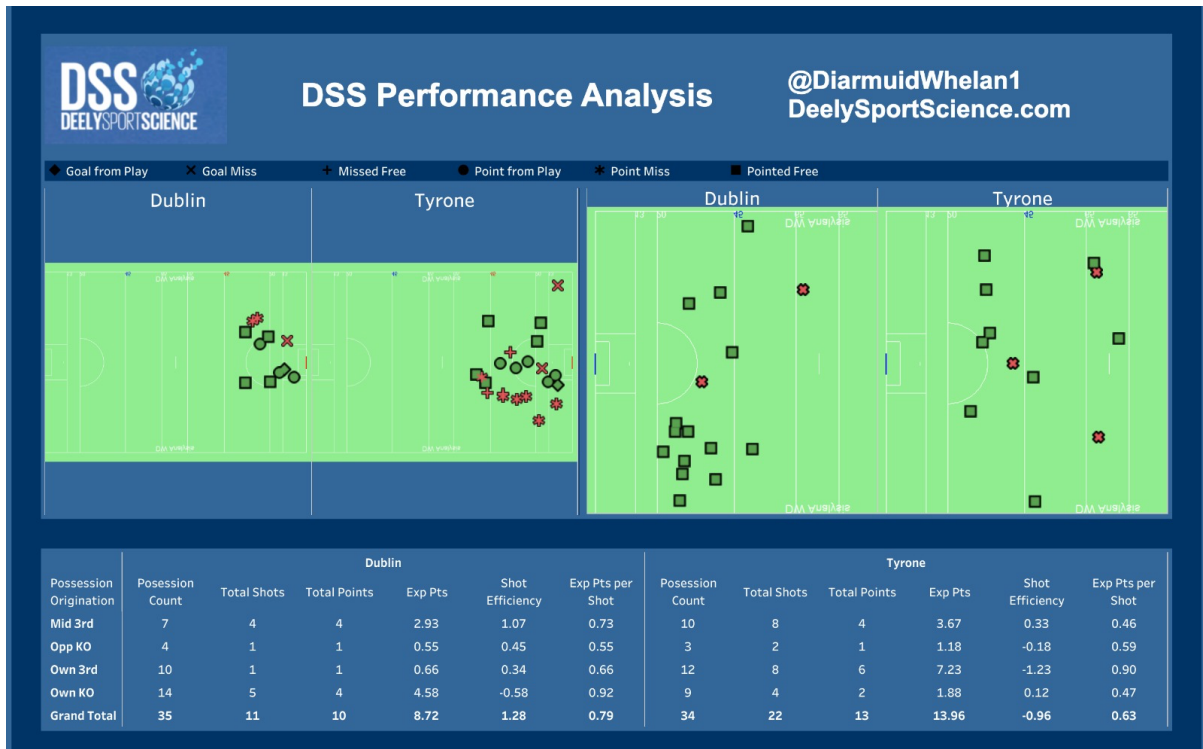
Dublin 1-07 Tyrone 1-10



Conditions had a significant impact on this game but Tyrone were well deserved winners. Dublin were not able to convert attacks into shots – something Tyrone managed very efficiently. Quantity over quality - Dublin's shots were significantly better quality than Tyrone's but the sheer number of shots at goal Tyrone generated, including those long range Morgan efforts, meant there was only one winner.

Level at half time, Tyrone would have felt they were playing well but hadn't capitalised on the scoreboard – possibly causing tempers to boil over in the tunnel! They continued their dominance and eventually got their rewards in the final 20.





Dublin again stuck to their principles of prioritising chance quality. They refused to take shots from low % locations whereas Tyrone managed to generate some from outside the scoring zone through the boot of Niall Morgan. Both teams conceded the kickout in the main with both teams struggling to convert their kickouts into scores – probably due to conditions.
